"Reference Points and Bonus Payments - Field Evidence from a Multinational Firm"*

We empirically investigate the effect of reference point violations on job satisfaction and performance of managerial employees in a large multinational company. We find strong evidence for the importance of reference points for both job satisfaction and performance. Negative deviations from a reference point induced by the incentive scheme have a significant negative effect on job satisfaction. But in addition, violations of employees' reference points also reduce future performance.

"Unambiguous Events and Dynamic Choquet Preferences" *

This paper explores the relationship between dynamic consistency and the notion of ambiguity for Choquet Expected Utility preferences. A decision maker is faced with an information structure represented by a filtration. We show that a decision maker is dynamic consistent if and only if the algebra generated by the last filtration is unambiguous in the sense of Nehring (1999).
