"History matters: Game length realizations and cooperation in indefinitely repeated games"

We study the effect of match length realization in experiments on indefinitely repeated games. We demonstrate substantial effects and show that they can impact treatment comparisons in three applications. Our results have implications for the study of learning in games as well as for methodological considerations when designing experiments.
