The **Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences** at Heidelberg University invites applications for an

**ASSISTANT PROFESSORSHIP in APPLIED ECONOMETRICS**  
**(Juniorprofessur W1 „Volkswirtschaftslehre mit dem**  
**Schwerpunkt Empirische Wirtschaftsforschung“)**

starting in April 2020. The position is available for a period of six years.

**Position remit**

The successful candidate (m/f/d) is expected to have a strong research interest in applied econometrics. Ideally, the research focus should be in financial econometrics, macroeconomics or time series econometrics. Teaching in the department's B.Sc. degree programme *Economics (Political Economy)* and/or the M.Sc. degree programme *Economics* is required, in compliance with the Baden-Württemberg Lehrverpflichtungsverordnung (regulation on teaching responsibilities). Teaching in English is possible. The course load is approximately one course per term.

**Requirements**

In accordance with Section 51 Landeshochschulgesetz Baden-Württemberg (the Baden-Württemberg State Higher Education Act), the successful candidate is expected to have an excellent Ph.D. in Economics or a related field, good pedagogical skills, and publications in international, peer-reviewed journals in the relevant field. For applicants who have held academic positions in Germany (before or after the doctorate), the total number of years for doctorate and prior post-doctoral employment should not exceed six years.

Provided that the general legal (German civil service law) and budgetary regulations are fulfilled, the appointed candidate can obtain temporary civil service status.

The university aims to increase the number of women in areas in which they have been underrepresented until now. Qualified female academics are especially invited to apply. Preference will be given to disabled applicants who are otherwise equally qualified for the position.

Applications should include a CV (description of academic background including teaching experience and a listing all relevant publications), a representative research paper ('job market paper'), at least two letters of reference (to be sent by the referees), a statement of research interests and of teaching philosophy and, if available, teaching evaluations. Complete applications should be sent by email to the Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences ([jobs@wiso.uni-heidelberg.de](mailto:jobs@wiso.uni-heidelberg.de)). The application deadline is **December 6, 2019**. Fly-outs are expected to take place on 22 and 23 January 2020.
